



Making the Connection

CHAPLAIN CARRIE KREPS WEGENAST

Tyson Foods, Inc.

Your generosity helps those like Carrie make the connection between being a student and a servant.

I walked a manufacturing line turning pork and beef into a stuffed sausage. I greeted team members with a wave and smile as I passed. I stopped to talk with a woman about her mom who fell and now needs more care. I shared a guick prayer of comfort with her as she worked. One team member asked for an appointment to share some good news. I am guessing it is baby pictures of her newest grandchild. I stop to see how a young woman is feeling. She was in my office to talk about depression. A young father is looking for childcare and asks if I can help. I write down his cellphone number to follow up. Another explained how he was late for his shift because his car would not start. I referred him to a non-profit agency I hope can help. This is my day as a manufacturing chaplain with Tyson Foods.

I care for the emotional, mental, and spiritual care of nearly 750 team members in a smoked meat plant in New London, Wisconsin. Addressing barriers to employment, such as reliable transporta-

tion, childcare, family joys and crisis, and mental health, is a big part of what I do as I provide chaplain services to a diverse group of people.

This is not quite what I expected when I graduated from seminary, paid for in part by a scholarship from the United Methodist Higher Education Foundation. This degree opened the door to local church ministry. I served in this capacity for ten years before answering a job ad and recognizing a call to be a chaplain for Tyson Foods.

The gift of the scholarship, matched by my home church in Cincinnati, Ohio, affirmed my call, supported my education, [and] enabled my ministry of service to the greater world.

Carrie is a 2003 UMHEF United Methodist Dollars for Scholars recipient. She has a BA from Ohio Northern University and a MDiv from Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary. She is currently working on a DMin in Interfaith Chaplaincy from United Theological Seminary of the Twin Cities. 66

Former UMHEF scholarship recipient now serves on the Board of Trustees to give back to United Methodists in need.

When I received a scholarship from UMHEF to help pay for my undergraduate education at Southern Methodist University, I had no idea of how great a blessing it really was. Of course, the money for tuition was appreciated, but what I didn't realize then was how the scholarship would further strengthen my connection with the church.

I grew up going to Sunday school and was active in my youth group during high school, but (like many college students) was not particularly involved thereafter. Receiving a scholarship from UMHEF was, to me, a reminder of who I was, where I came from, and the community I belonged to.

While at SMU, I received frequent reminders from UMHEF about the church's support for me and for hundreds of other students like me across the country. UMHEF stayed in touch with me after graduation, through law school, and as I began my career. As a young adult, I was eager to become a donor to UMHEF. I wanted to pay back the gift that had been given to me, so

that other students like me could have the same opportunities-not just to attend a church-related college or university, but to do so with the love and support of their church community. My UMHEF scholarship inspired me to rekindle my involvement at church as an adult and to take on leadership roles in my local congregation.

I have also been honored to serve on UMHEF's board of trustees since 2010. I support UMHEF now because I know that the scholarships we give are so much more than assistance with tuition. Our scholarships are a way for the church to connect with its youth during a transformational time in their lives and to inspire its future leaders.

Jadd first received a UMHEF scholarship in 1995 as a student at Southern Methodist University and is now a lawyer living in Dallas, TX. He first joined the UMHEF Board of Trustees in 2010 and has since served in many roles of leadership.

GENERAL NAMED ENDOWED PROGRAM

This program manages and distributes over 130 endowed scholarship funds established by various donors. These scholarships are often created in memory of a person or are ongoing legacies created with estate plans.

UNITED METHODIST DOLLARS FOR SCHOLARS PROGRAM

This unique program begins with a \$1,000 scholarship from a student's local UM church, which UMHEF matches ("Double" Award). Additional matches may come from participating UM-related schools ("Triple" Award) and UM Conference Foundations ("Quadruple" Award). The award total could reach up to \$4,000.




As Joshua continues his studies at Wesley, he looks for ways to serve others near and far in the years to come.
