



UNITED METHODIST DOLLARS FOR SCHOLARS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

For 2023-2024 Academic Year

BASIC CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

- You must be an active, full member of The United Methodist Church for at least one year prior to applying. New for 2023: Members of the African Methodist Episcopal Church, AME Zion Church, and Christian Methodist Episcopal Church are also eligible.
- You must be enrolled or planning to enroll in a full-time degree program (graduate or undergraduate) at a United Methodist-related college, university, or seminary in the United States.
- Doctoral (Ph.D. and other) candidates are not eligible at this time.

HOW DOLLARS FOR SCHOLARS WORKS

Through the United Methodist Dollars for Scholars (UMDFS) program, the United Methodist Higher Education Foundation (UMHEF) provides \$1,000 matching scholarships to students who have received a \$1,000 scholarship from their local church to help them attend a United Methodist-related college, university, or seminary.

Awards are made for the fall term of each academic year and are generally distributed directly to schools in mid-November. Please note that YOU MUST APPLY ANNUALLY TO BE AWARDED A SCHOLARSHIP FOR EACH SCHOOL YEAR.

Additional matching funds may be available to eligible United Methodist applicants through the Triple Your Dollars and Quadruple Your Dollars components of the UMDFS program. The number of available matching scholarships is determined annually. Available matching funds include scholarships designated for Hispanic-, Asian-, and Native-American (HANA) students funded by the United Methodist General Board of Higher Education and Ministry.

HOW TO APPLY

DEADLINE: MARCH 1, 2023

Applications will be accepted beginning January 1, 2023 for the 2023-2024 academic year. The application and all required documents must be **postmarked no later than March 1, 2023.**(June 1, 2023 for students planning to enroll in a 2-year college only)

- 1. Complete in full. Every question must be answered and all sections of the form must be completed; please type or print legibly. Review the Application Check List on the last page before submitting.
- 2. Applications must be postmarked by March 1, 2023 (June 1, 2023 for students planning to enroll in a two-year college only).
- 3. Submit this paper application or apply online, not both. Submit online at umhef.org. You will be considered for only one award from UMHEF during an academic year.
- 4. A check for \$1,000 payable to
 UMHEF from the sponsoring church
 (no personal checks) must be mailed
 with the completed application. If
 submitting online, you will be
 provided a confirmation form to
 complete and return by the March 1
 deadline to UMHEF with your check.
 Applications submitted online will
 not be processed until the mailed
 check is received.

PARTICIPATING FOUNDATIONS & SCHOOLS

\$\$ DOUBLE YOUR DOLLARS

Students attending United Methodist- related institutions not participating in the Triple Your Dollars level may receive a total award of \$2,000 when UMHEF matches your church's initial \$1,000 scholarship. These schools are listed as Double Your Dollars participants.

\$\$\$ TRIPLE YOUR DOLLARS

Students attending United Methodist-related institutions participating in the Triple Your Dollars level could receive \$1,000 in matching funds from the school. Combined with UMHEF's match, the award may total up to \$3,000. These schools are listed as Triple Your Dollars participants. Contact your school's financial aid office for information about how their matching award will be granted.

\$\$\$\$ QUADRUPLE YOUR DOLLARS

At the Quadruple Your Dollars level, participating United Methodist conference foundations may provide up to an additional \$1,000 match to recipients sponsored by churches in their conferences. The total award could reach up to \$4,000. Recipients must be attending a Triple Your Dollars participating institution to be eligible for this match; other restrictions may apply per conference foundation. These foundations are listed as Quadruple Your Dollars participants.

DEADLINE: Applications will be accepted beginning January 1, 2023 and must be received via standard mail postmarked no later than March 1, 2023 with the exception of applications from students planning to enroll in a two-year UM-related college, which may be received with a postmark no later than June 1, 2023. If possible, you are encouraged to submit your application at least one month prior to the deadline to allow for early processing. No awards will be announced prior to May 1, 2023.

DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS: Awarded funds are generally distributed to schools by mid-November of the Fall semester. Please know that we will contact you if there is an issue with your award. Due to a high volume of inquires, we may be unable to confirm when your award has been sent to your school.
